Because of the new swine (novel H1N1) flu virus strain, this influenza season is not business as usual. That's why for the best possible protection this winter, most people will need a special H1N1 flu vaccine AND a seasonal vaccine.

Target Groups for H1N1 Flu Vaccine

It's especially important for people at higher risk for serious complications to get this vaccine:

- √ Pregnant women
- √ Persons who live with or care for infants under the age of 6 months (Includes parents, siblings and daycare providers.)
- √ Persons aged 6 months through 24 years
- √ Persons aged 25 through 64 years with high-risk medical conditions
- √ Healthcare and emergency medical services workers
