Scale 1" = 100 Ft

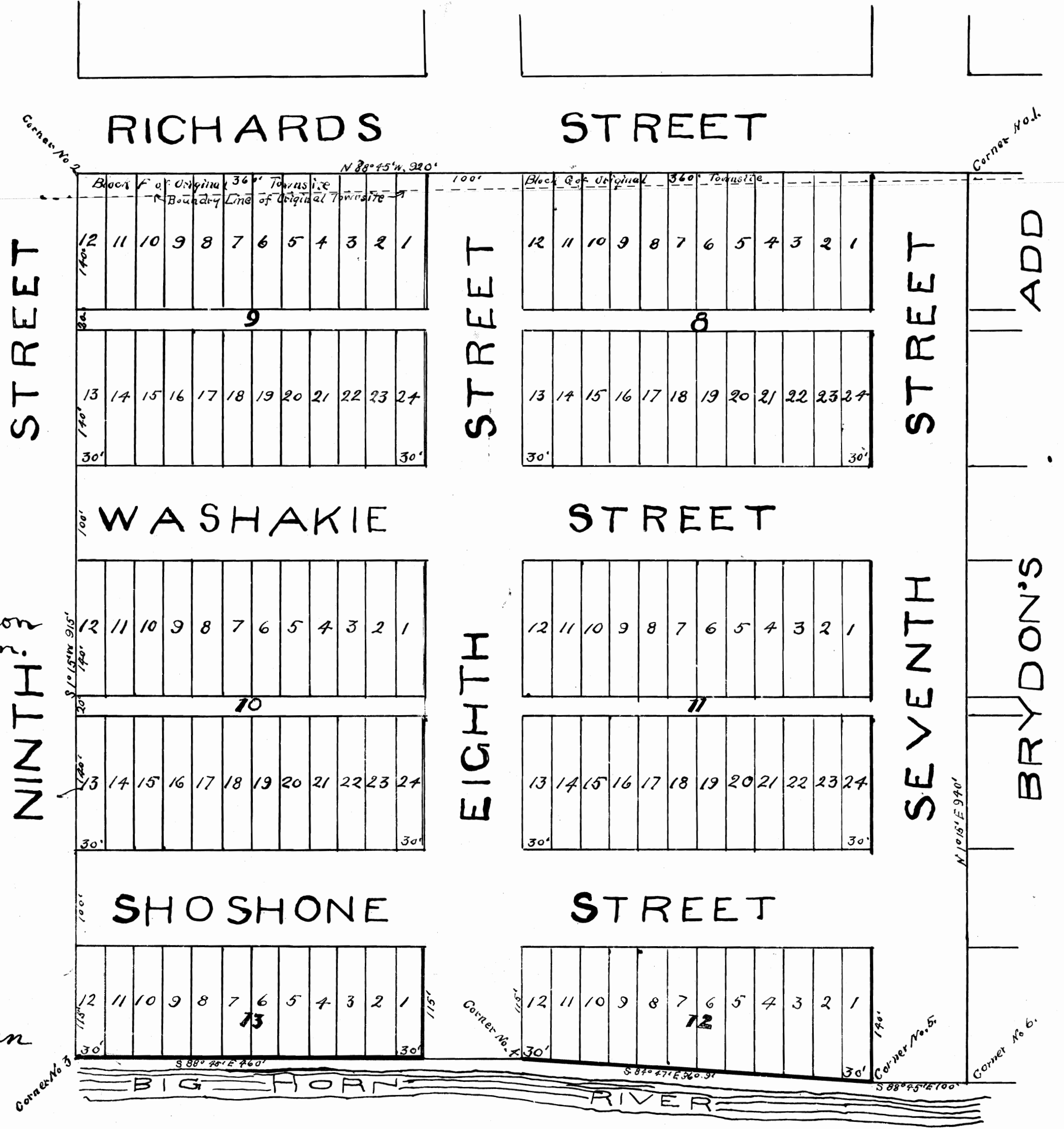
## ORIGINAL TOWN

**DEDICATION**  
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, ROBERT BRYDON and PHEMIE BRYDON, owners and proprietors, have caused the above plat to be surveyed and plotted to be known as BRYDON'S THIRD ADDITION to the TOWNSITE of THERMOPOLIS, and that the streets and alleys as shown on said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public; that the above and foregoing subdivision of the the tract described as follows: Beginning at corner No. 1, which is identical with the northwest corner of BRYDON'S ADDITION to the TOWNSITE of THERMOPOLIS (FREMONT Co. WYO.), thence N. 88° 45' W. 920. ft to corner No. 2, thence S. 1° 15' W. 915. ft to corner No. 3, thence S. 88° 45' E. 460. ft to corner No. 4, thence S. 84° 47' E. 360. 9 ft to corner No. 5, thence S. 88° 45' E. 100. ft to corner No. 6, thence N. 1° 15' E. 940. ft to corner No. 1, the place of beginning, as appears on this plat, is made with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owners and proprietors.
