

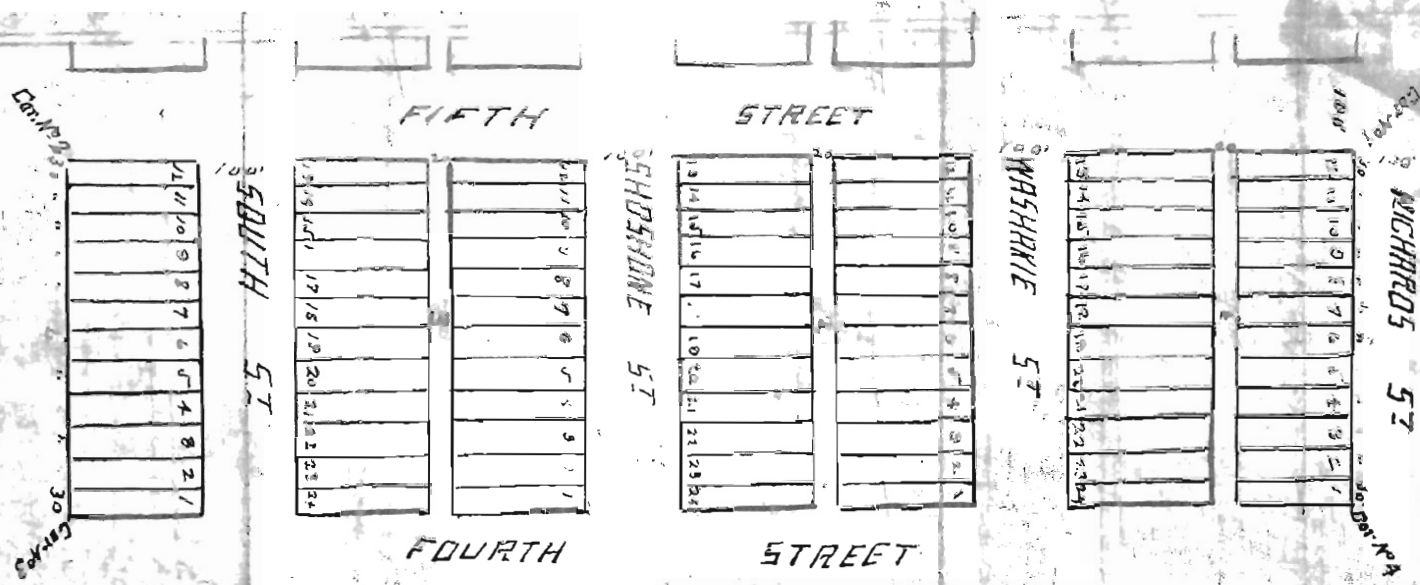
MAP OF EDWARDS ADDITION

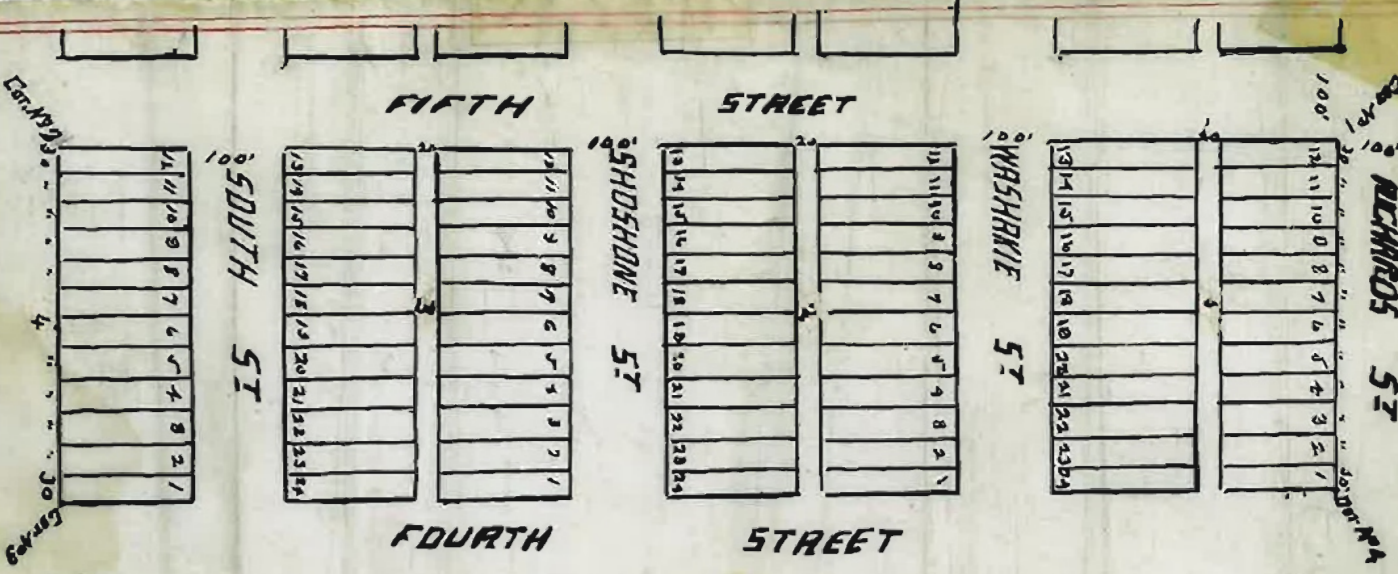
DESCRIPTION

Beginning at the intersection of Fifth Street and Nichols Street according  
 to the original plat of the town of Thermopolis and by the S. E. Corner  
 of Block No 53 thence East 100 feet thence South 100 feet to corner  
 No 1 thence South 1340 feet to corner No 2. Thence East 360 feet to  
 corner No 3. Thence North 1340 feet to corner No 4. Thence West  
 360 feet to corner No 1 in place of beginning
