

**River & Stream Conditions
In Hot Springs County
Effective August 14, 2018**

Bighorn River Information:

As of this date the Bighorn River is flowing at 1250 cubic feet/second. After much higher flows during the spring snowmelt runoff season, this is considered a typical summertime level.

Remember that wearing a personal floatation device will greatly increase your safety should an accident occur.

Stream drainages across the county are very low and pose no threat to public safety.

With these conditions in mind, the Hot Springs County River & Stream Awareness Level is set at GREEN.
