

**River & Stream Conditions
In Hot Springs County
Effective June 10**

Bighorn River Information:

As of this date the Bighorn River is flowing at 3000 cubic feet/second.

Today that will be increased to 3500cfs and to 4000cfs within the next several days.

Remember that wearing a personal floatation device will greatly increase your safety should an accident occur.

Stream drainages across the county are high but pose no threat to public safety or property.

With these conditions in mind, the Hot Springs County River & Stream Awareness Level is set at YELLOW.
