

**Boysen Dam – Big Horn River
Situation Report
Tuesday, July 2, 2019**

FLOW REDUCTION UPDATE

At 1:00 pm on Tuesday July 2, 2019, release flows from Boysen Dam will be decreased to 3500cfs

This number much more closely reflects a typical summertime flow.

Those on the river are still urged:

- Do not float the river alone
- WEAR personal flotation devices
- Avoid floating near trees and brush along the banks of the river and give a wide berth to bridge pilings
- Do not consume alcohol or recreational drugs
- Let someone know where you will be putting in and where and what time you expect to exit the river.

The HSC River & Stream Awareness Level will remain at Yellow until the flow drops below 3000cfs.
