**FLOW REDUCTION UPDATE**

With flows in the Bighorn River once again below 3000 cfs, we can return the River and Stream Awareness level to GREEN.

The flow on this date is 2700 cfs and that may be slowly decreased as irrigation demands lessen through the summer.

Streams throughout the county are at typically low summertime levels.

Those floating the river are still urged:

- Do not float the river alone
- WEAR personal flotation devices
- Avoid floating near trees and brush along the banks of the river and give a wide berth to bridge pilings
- Do not consume alcohol or recreational drugs
- Let someone know where you will be putting in and where and what time you expect to exit the river.

We've got our summer Bighorn River back. Enjoy!
